Amber was awarded Champion 11 yr old girl swimmer of the carnival.


On top of those great results Carrathool was named Small Schools Champion of the carnival. (Points are awarded for place results and divided by the competitors).

#### Accident insurance

To insure your child against any medical costs of accidents arising at school you are strongly advised to take out private health insurance or check if your school is covered for school accident insurance available via your school's P&C Association.

Parents are reminded that the department does not provide accident or medical insurance for students enrolled in government schools. The only cover provided by the state government is through the Supplementary Sporting Injuries Benefits Scheme, which covers all students permanently injured or killed while participating in authorised school sporting or athletic activities. The scheme does not cover dental injuries, reimbursement of medical expenses, legal expenses or costs. 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#### Summer water safety
