All year six students have attended their high school orientation days. Everyone has enjoyed themselves at them and we hope the transition from primary to secondary school has been made a little easier for them.


School reports will go home next Thursday 11th December. If you would like an interview to discuss your child's/children's progress, please don't hesitate to contact me.
